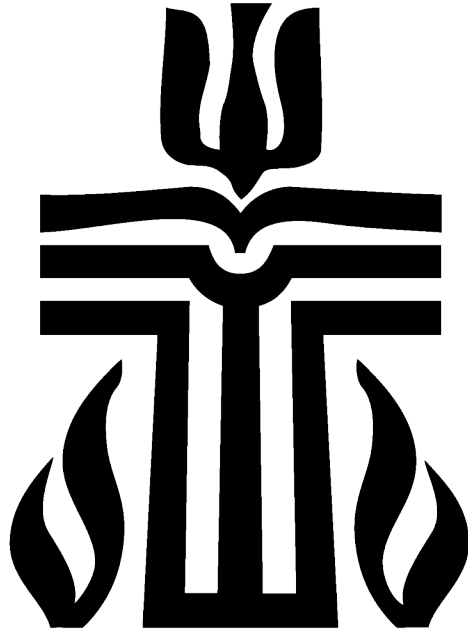

This 1200 acre area encompasses a Native American settlement that dates back to 500 A.D. There are 17 remaining ceremonial mounds and a museum, which is constructed to replicate a Native American mound - it reflects the history and culture of the area.
