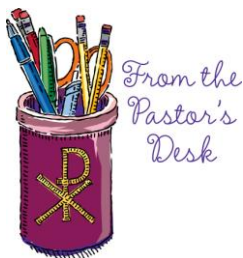

The new mower has been used by Joe Bishop, Walt Schrimper, Roy Wynne and Dossett.

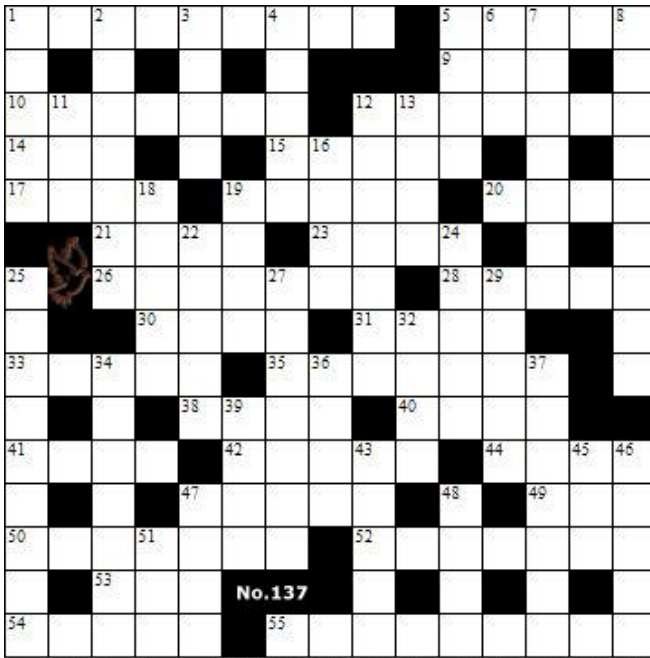
All agree that it takes much practice to become proficient at driving it, but it is definitely worth it because it is so much better suited to our needs with its power and speed.
